Sub: Observing 'Cyber Jaagrukta (Awareness) Diwas' on first Wednesday of every month by NSS units- reg.

Sir/ Madam,

In reference to DO letter No 22003/15/2018-I4C dated 30th March, 2022 signed by Home Secretary, Govt of India regarding above mentioned subject (copy enclosed).

2. I am to refer to the subject cited above and to intimate that the Ministry of Home Affairs has launched the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre (I4C) to strengthen the capabilities of law Enforcement Agencies (LEAs) and improve coordination among the LEAs and other agencies. The MHA has also launched the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal (NCRP) to facilitate online reporting of cyber crime incidents. The analyses have revealed that 60% of the complaints are related to online financial frauds. Hence, the MHA has also rolled out the Citizen Financial Cyber Fraud Reporting & Management System (CFCFRMS), as part of the NCRP for immediate reporting of financial frauds and also for stopping the siphoning off the funds by fraudsters.

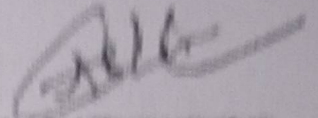
3. Therefore, it has been decided by the Ministry of Youth Affairs & Sports and Ministry of Home Affairs to observe the "Cyber Jaagrukta (Awareness) Diwas (CJD)" on the first Wednesday of every month in all the school/ colleges/ Universities/ Panchayati Raj Institutions (PRIs) and Municipalities.

4. In this regard, an online meeting under the chairmanship of CEO (I4C) with all State NSS Officers (SNOs) and Programme Coordinators was held on 03 June 2024. During the meeting, following have been proposed in respect of participation of NSS Volunteers/ POs for better coordination and implementation of schemes related to cyber crimes:-

- (a) Training of NSS Volunteers/ POs on Cyber Crime Prevention/ Control procedures/ policies.
- (b) Recognition/Registration of NSS Volunteers as Cyber volunteers.
- (c) Universities/ Colleges and NSS Volunteers may form the Cyber Clubs in their respective Universities/ Colleges.
- (d) National Cyber Crime Training Centre has CyTrain Portal in which Cyber Crime related material courses available as well as courses on IGOT portal.
- (e) Universities/ Colleges may organise some contests based on cyber hygiene, the Cyber Olympiad etc. annually.
- (f) For Dissemination of Cyber Hygiene messages, Universities/ Colleges may award the Best Professors/ Teachers/ NSS Volunteers during their Annual Functions.

5. In view of the above, all NSS Programme Coordinators are requested to ensure participation of NSS Volunteers/ Programme Officers in observation of "Ojha Jagrookta (Awareness) Diwas (CJD)" on the first Wednesday of every month in all the school/ colleges/ Universities under your jurisdiction.
