## INTRODUCTION

The Constitution of India has given special attention to the needs of women to enable them to exercise their rights on equal footing with men and participate in national development. It aims at creation of an entirely new social order where, all citizens are given equal opportunities for growth and development and that no discrimination takes place on the basis of race, religion, caste, sex, etc. Almost half of the population in India is occupied by women. But it is very unfortunate that for long years there have been a strong bias against women and thereby there is a tendency to deny equal socio-economic opportunity for them. This neglecting attitude towards women is prominent in many respects particularly in the field of education.

Over the past years of women to higher education has improved significantly. However, progress is still possible, notably their participation in fields such as science and technology. In contrast, the presence of a critical mass of women in the decision-making process remains vastly inadequate. Also, a number of cultural barriers still exist which seriously impedes their development as citizens and professionals.

The two day National Seminar aims at addressing the issue of 'Women in Higher Education: Policies and Perspectives'. The discourse shall take the trajectory of history of women's education to contemporary position of women in higher education, the problems and challenges, the various socio-cultural impediments women face in this sector, the programmes and policies of the State to mitigate and improve the situation, also the impact of neo-liberal policies, etc. shall be addressed. It will point to strategies which may help higher education stakeholders in their efforts to strengthen the role of women in higher education sector and their contribution to social development in general.
