ABOUT CHIMUR

Chimur city is located in Chandrapur district (M. S.). Chimur is famous for its active participation in the Indian Freedom Struggle during the "Quit India" movement of 1942. Rashtrasant Tukdoji Maharaj was residing at Chimur during the early days of his life. During the "Quit India" movement many people participated in the Satyagraha. During the "Quit India" movement, Balaji Raipurkar and Babulal Zire were killed when the British troops opened fire on the satyagrahis. Following this incident, the British government cracked down heavily on the freedom fighters and the people of Chimur. The British troops committed severe atrocities on the satyagrahis. There is a monument, 'Shaheed Smarak' is later constructed in the memory of freedom fighters. There is a Balaji temple in Chimur which is more than 300 years old. This temple was constructed during the Bhosale reign. The idol in this temple is strikingly similar to the idol in the famous Trupati Balaji temple. This temple is famous for the "Ghodayatra" which begins as per Hindu calendar on Magh Shuddha Trayodashi. During the "Ghodayatra" the idol is paraded through town in a colorful procession which is attended by devotees in large numbers. The famous Tadoba-Andhari Tiger Project & National Park is at a distance of 10 km from Chimur. This park is a successful example of conservation of the Tiger. The other animal species found in Tadoba are Bear, Gava (Indian Bison) and Chital (Indian Spotted Deer). The park is also famous for its bio-diversity. Hospitality services are available in the park. Jungle Safaris and lodging facilities make a visit to the Tadoba-Andhari Park a worthwhile experience. There are three gates for
