AVISHKAR - 2015

This year Savitribai Fule Pune University, Pune is organizing the State level Inter-university Research Festival "Avishkar-2015" during 15th to 17th January 2016. Avishkar hosts a galaxy of events aimed at boosting the scientific, technological and management skills in today's youth, it provides them with an opportunity to showcase their fields of expertise. In the first stage the college level competition will be organized and the best entries would be selected for onward participation at District level, University level and Inter-University Competition. All the colleges are expected to participate in this competition aimed at providing a common platform to young and inquisitive minds.

AIMS AND OBJECTIVES:

- · To inculcate research culture among students.
- To encourage original and novel thing.
- · To provide an opportunity for expression of academic talent.
- To promote interaction among academic, R & D Institutes and Industries.

MODE OF SELECTION OF PROJECTS

STAGE-1: COLLEGE LEVEL COMPETITION

The colleges and institutions will conduct competitions at their level in the categories mentioned below between 14th to 17th December 2015 and shortlist two projects from each category for UG, PG, PPG & Teachers for participation at STAGE – II.

STAGE- II : DISTRICT LEVEL COMPETITION

Short listed students from STAGE-I will be required to display and present their on 22nd & 23rd December 2015 at District level for their selection to the University team. District level competition will be organized at Janta College, Chandrapur.

STAGE-III: UNIVERSITY LEVEL

The short listed candidates from STAGE- II will have to submit their projects along with research papers and C.D.'s to the Director, Students' Welfare, Gondwana University for their evaluation by subject experts and final selection of University Team.

STAGE- IV: STATE LEVEL

The selected team at STAGE- III will be entitled to present their projects at Inter University Research Competition AVISHKAR to be held at Savitribai Fule Pune University, Pune during 15th to 17th January 2016. At stage IV level only one candidate/entry will participate.

PROGRAMME FOR STAGE - II

- Day I: Poster: Model display of research projects in the form of exhibits. This will be judged by the subject experts in the field. Experts will short list the candidates for oral presentations.
- Day II: It is divided into two session, Pre-Lunch and Post-Lunch.
- Pre-Lunch Session: Oral presentations strictly by students of selected/shortlisted research projects in each category.
- Post-Lunch Session: Lectures by the eminent personalities in the field on various projects of research training in the relevant areas, followed by prize distribution ceremony.

Guidelines to the Participants

- Projects should be in the form of live demonstration/models/posters (1m x 1m size) and should bring out innovative ideas in their respective categories.
- The college/institution can send maximum two entries each at Under Graduate Level, PG level Post PG level (M. Phil/Ph. D.) Teachers in every category.
- At STAGE- I and STAGE- II, Participants are expected to display their projects before the panel of subject experts nominated by the authorities. The subject experts will shortlist the entries for oral presentations.
- Shortlist projects of STAGE- I and STAGE- II will also have to give an oral presentation before the panel of subject experts.
- Each oral presentation will be given 8 minutes followed by questions and answers for 2 minutes.
- 6. Each participating team shall not have more than one students engaged in the project.
- 7. Infrastructural facilities like working space, electricity, water, tables, mounting boards, LCD projector, overhead projector etc., will be made available to the participants by the organizing college/institution. For requirements other than the above mentioned facilities, participants should inform the coordinator well in advance.
- All entries for STAGE- II should be forwarded through the Principal of the College/Head of Institution.
- Registration is compulsory for all participants (Registration fee for STAGE- II: Rs. 100/-/entry/students)
- 10. Each participant will be given the participation certificate by the University.
- 11. Each decision of subject experts/judges will be final and binding on all participants.
- All winning teams will be informed about their selection on the same day.

IMPORTANT INSTRUCTIONS FOR PARTICIPANTS

- · The entries must be forwarded through Principal/Head of Institution.
- Maximum two entries in each category will be accepted for STAGE- II.
- The participating team will have to register themselves at least FIVE days before the STAGE-II competition.

CATEGORIES FOR PARTICIPANT

- · Humanities, Languages, Fine Arts etc.
- · Commerce, Management, Law etc.
- · Pure Sciences.
- · Agriculture and Animal Husbandry.
- Medicine and Pharmacy.
- Engineering & Technology.

Inter disciplinary projects will also be accepted for presentation. However, the candidates must specify the category in which their project is to be placed.

Note :- Instructions:

- The Entry Form should be accompanied with a Cash or D.D. of Rs. 100/- per participant in favour of principal, Janta College, Chandrapur.
- 2) The participating students should carry with them the ID card of the college.
- 3) Exhibits should be displayed on 22nd December 2015 by 12.00 pm.
- There are no restrictions of subjects. Any students from any discipline can participate under any categories.
- 5) Name of the college or participants is not allowed on the exhibit.
- 6) Exhibits will be evaluated by Judges for the award.
- The short listed participants will have to make oral presentation of their research projects.
- 8) For the oral presentation LCD of Overhead Projector will be provided. The power point presentation will be preferred. Therefore, each team should come prepared for the oral presentation.
- 9) The time for oral presentation will be 10 minutes.
- 10) Each participating college will have to make their own arrangement of boarding for the participating members.
- 11) Entry form should be sent to Principal, Janta College Chandrapur.



ELIGIBILITY RULES FOR AVISHKAR

All universities of Maharashtra State can participate in Avishkar 2014. Students recommended by the competent authorities of concerned universities are allowed to participate in the event.

Disciplines (Theme area group):

- (i) Humanities, Languages, Fine Arts
- (ii) Commerce, Management, Law
- (iii) Pure Sciences
- (iv) Agriculture and Animal Husbandry
- (v) Engineering and Technology
- (vi) Medicine and Pharmacy

The motive of organizing "Avishkar" is to encourage the original research and motivate innovation in research culture in any of the above disciplines. Therefore, to facilitate inter-disciplinary participation, the students can participate from any one of the above discipline.

Levels of participation:

- (i) Undergraduate students (UG)
- (ii) Post-graduate students (PG)
- (iii) Post-PG students (PPG)
- (iv) In-service teachers (TH)

Eligibility criteria:

- 1. Only bonafide, full time student, who is enrolled for a degree or Post-graduate degree or diploma course of a minimum duration of one academic year and whose examination is conducted by the university subsequent to passing of the 12th class examination will be eligible. Students of open universities shall be considered to be bonafide students and will be eligible for participation provided they fulfill other terms and conditions. However, students enrolled in correspondence course in Institute / Centres of universities, casual students, external students and students pursuing bridge courses shall not be eligible.
- 2. Student from any level / discipline can participate under any of the above disciplines.
- 3. All the participating students for Avishkar 2014, shall fulfill the following conditions:

For Undergraduate students (UG):

Students pursuing studies in the participating university or its constituent / affiliated colleges or recognized institutes who are below the age of 25 years are eligible to participate in any of the six disciplines depending upon the area of his/her research work irrespective of the faculty/stream/subject in which he/she has enrolled for the degree/diploma in the participating university.





For Post-Graduate Students (PG):

Any student pursuing studies in the participating university or its constituent/affiliated colleges or a recognized institute who is below the age of 30 years is eligible to participate in any of the six disciplines depending upon the area of his / her research work irrespective of the faculty/stream/subject in which he / she has enrolled for the Post Graduate degree/diploma in the participating university.

For Post-PG Students (PPG):

Any person from the participating university or its constituent/affiliated college or recognized institute, who has duly registered for (i) a degree such as M. Phil. / Ph.D. or (ii) registered for D.Sc. / D.Litt., etc. having acquired Post Graduate degree/diploma in the said subject/stream/faculty or (iii) pursuing Post Doctoral Research is eligible to participate in any of the six disciplines depending upon the area of his/her research project irrespective of the faculty/stream/subject in which he/she has enrolled for the said programme in the participating university without any stipulated age limit.

For Teachers (TH):

Regarding the participation of teacher/s in the Avishkar, only the teachers who are pursuing their M. Phil / Ph. D. will be allowed to participate and **not those** who have completed their M. Phil. or Ph.D. degree/s and guiding the students for M. Phil. or Ph. D.

- 1. A student shall not be allowed to represent more than one university during a single academic year.
- Provisional admission to a course of a university or college shall not make the student eligible to represent the university in the Avishkar.
- In case of a student migrating from one university to another his / her migration case will be considered
 eligible only after his / her admission in the new university is regularized and he/she is admitted as a
 bonafide student by the new university.

Prizes and Trophies:

Cash prize to winners of each level:

First Prize

: Rs. 5,000/-

Second Prize

: Rs. 3,000/-

2. Trophies:

Championship Trophy (rotating) will be awarded to winner from each discipline (six).

General Championship Trophy (rotating) will be awarded to the Winner and Runner-up university bagging maximum prizes.

3. Certificate of participation will be awarded to all the participants.
