## ORDINANCE NO. 100 OF 2017

EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF MASTER OF COMPUTER APPLICATION(M.C.A.) SEMESTER PATTERN WITH CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM, ORDINANCE, 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to amend ordinance No. 83 of 2017 in respects of Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Computer Application(M.C.A.) semester pattern with choice based credit system Ordinance, 2017, for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following ordinance:-

- **1.** This Ordinance may be called "Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Computer Application(M.C.A.) semester pattern with choice based credit system, (Amendment)Ordinance,2017."
- **2.** This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of admission to the M.C.A. part-I(Semester I) and direct admission to M.C.A. III rd semester from the Academic Session 2017-18.
- **3.** Matter as 'Eliligibility: clauses a) and b)" under para '6' of Ordinance No. 83 of 2017 in respect of "Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Computer Application(M.C.A.) semester pattern with choice based credit system, Ordinance, 2017." Substituted by the following matter:— "Eligibility criteria for appearing to MAH-MCA-CET and for admission to MCA. Part –I(Semester I & II courses and Examinations)
  - a) Candidate having valid CET Score(i.e.- candidate securing Zero or negative marks in MAH-MCA-CET or any other equivalent CET will not be considered eligible for the admission) and fulfill the following eligibility criteria-
    - (i) The candidate should be an Indian National;
    - (ii) Passed minimum three year duration Bachelor's Degree awarded by university recognized by U.G.C. or A.I.U. in any discipline with at least 50% marks in aggregate(Aggregate marks means the grand total of marks obtained by the candidate in subjects based on which a class declaration is made in the particular university from which the candidate is passing the qualifying examination) or equivalent(at least 45% in case of candidates of backward class categories and person with Disability belonging to Maharashtra State only;
    - (iii)Studied Mathematics as one of the subjects at (10+2) level or at graduate level examination.

b) Direct admission to M.C.A. Part II(Semester III):- The candidate should have passed Bachelor Degree in computer Application or science(Information Technology or Computer Science)

OR

The candidate should have passed the PGDCS&A Examination of the university or of R.T.M. Nagpur university Nagpur.

This direct admission shall be subject to satisfaction of other norms and availability of seats in the institution running M.C.A. Course."

## (Statement of object and reasons)

State common entrance test cell, Government of Maharashtra, Mumbai vide No.CETCELL/MCA-Notice-1/2017/57 dated 2/2/2017 has notified eligibility criteria for appearing to MAH-MCA-CET 2017 for admission to M.C.A. part I(I st and II nd semester) from the Academic Session 2017-18.

In the light of eligibility criteria notified as mentioned in above para, the eligibility criteria provided under Ordinance No. 83 of 2017 was required to be changed for admission to 1 st semeseter and direct admission to III rd semester of M.C.A. Degree course hence this Draft Ordinance is prepared for amending Ordinance no. 83 of 2017.
