Examinations leading to the Degrees of M.A.(History, Political science, sociology, Home Economics, Geography, Ambedkar thought, Mass communication, Economics), M.S.W. and M.,Lib. I.Sc., choice based credit system in semester pattern (Two years post Graduate course) in the faculty of social science (Amendment) ordinance, 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to amend ordinance NO. 80 of 2017 in respect of Examinations leading to the Degrees of M.A.(History, Political Science, sociology, Home Economics, Geography, Ambedkar Thought, Mass communication, Economics), M.S.W.and M.Lib. I.Sc., choice based credit system in semester pattern (Two years Post Graduate course) in the faculty of social sciences ordinance, 2017, for the purposes hereinafter appearing, the Management council is hereby pleased to make the following Ordinance:-

- 1. This Ordinance may be called "Examinations leading to the Degrees of M.A. (History, Political Science, sociology, Home Economics, Geography, ambedkar Thoght, Mass communication, Economics), M.S.W. and M. Lib. I.Sc, choice based credit system in semester pattern (Two years Post Graduate course), in the faculty of social sciences (Amendment) Ordinance, 2017."
- 2. This ordinance shall come into force with effect from the Academic session2017-2018 for semesters I & II and 2018-2019 for semesters III & IV. relating to MSW course frame work.
- 3. 'Appendix VII' Appended with ordinance- No. 80 of 2017 in respect of Examinations leading to the Degrees of M.A. (History, Political science, sociology, Home Economics Geography, Ambedkar Thought, Mass communication, Economics.)
 - M.S.W. and M.Lib.I.Sc, choice based credit system in semester pattern(Two years Post Graduate course), in the faculty of social sciences Ordinance,2017 be substituted by the 'Appendix –VII append with this ordinance containing course and Examination schemes, Table of conversion of marks to Grades and Grade point in credit system and Marks scheme for social work practicum & research project.

(Statement of object and reasons)

Board of studies in social work in its meeting held on 31/01/2017 has prepared the course and Examination shemes for semester I,II,III and IV of the Master's Degree examinations in social work alongwith a table of conversion of Marks to grades and grade point in credit system and Marks scheme for social work practicum and research project, based on 50% passing machable to choice based credit system and recommended the above matter to the faculty of social scienes.

The Dean of the faculty of social sciences has accepted and recommended the above matter to the Academic Council on 1/02/2017.

Hon'ble Vice Chancellor has accepted the said matter under provision of sub-section(7) of section 14 of the Maharashtra Universities Act, 1994 on behalf of the Academic Council. Because of this an Appendix VII appended with Ordinance No. 80 of 2017 was required to be substituted by the Appendix VII appended with this Ordinance to give effect to the provisions of said Appendix from the Academic Session 2017-2018 for semesters I & II and 2018-19 for semesters III & IV hence this Draft Ordinance is prepared for amending Ordinance No. 80 of 2017.
