GONDWANA UNIVERSITY, GADCHIROLI ORDINANCE NO. 104 OF 2017

EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF MASTER OF SCIENCE, SEMESTER PATTERN WITH CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM, IN THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE (AMENDMENT), ORDINANCE, 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to prepare an ordinance in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, Semester pattern with choice based credit system i.e. Ordinance No. 79 of 2017, for the prupose hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following ordinance;

- 1. This Ordinance may be called "Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, Semester pattern with choice based credit system, in the Faculty of Science(Amendement) Ordinance, 2017".
- **2.** This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its making by the Management Council.
- **3.** After 'Appendix-23' and before 'Appendix-24' in ordinance regarding Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, Semester pattern with choice based credit system, in the Faculty of Science, Ordinance,2017 i.e. Ordinance No. 79 of 2017 an Appendix-23(A) appended with this Ordinance be inserted.

(Statement of object and reasons)

In Ordinance No. 79 of 2017 the provision for grade and grade points at Master's Degree level in the Faculty of Science is made as stated in Appendix 23 appended with an ordinance in respect 'Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, Semester pattern with choice based credit system, in the Faculty of Science Ordinance, 2017.'

The said Appendix-23 is applicable to all Master's Degree courses in the Faculty of Science except the subject Mathematics. The provision of Appendix 23 can not be made applicable to the students offering Mathematics as a subject at Master's Degree level because of delivery in the Marks of the subject Mathematics. For making provision for an examinee offering Mathematics as a subject was to be made for grade and grade points hence Direction No. 2 of 2017 dated 8/02/2017 was issue by the Vice Chancellor under provision of sub-section(8) of section 14 of the Maharashtra universities Act, 1994. The Said Direction was required to be converted into an ordinance, hence this Draft Ordinance is prepared.
