Ordinance No. 7 OF 2017

Examination leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed. One year Degree Course) in the Faculty of Education Ordinance, 2017.

Whereas it is expedient to provide for Ordinance relating to examination Leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Physical Education in the faculty of Education for the purposed hereinafter appearing the Management Council is here by pleased to make the following Ordinance:-

1. This Ordinance May be Called “ Examination Leading to the Degree of Bachelor of physical Education (B.P.Ed. One year Degree Course) in the Faculty of Education, Ordinance, 2017.
2. This Ordinance Shall come into force with effect form the date of it making by the Management Council.
3. The Examination leading to the Degree Bachelor of Physical Education (B. P. Ed.) (One Year Degree Course) shall be held annually at such places and on such dates I as may be appointed by the Board of Examination.
4. Subjects to his compliance with the provisions of this Ordinance and other Ordinance in force from time to time, an applicant for admission to the Bachelor of Physical Education (one year Degree Course) shall :-
 - (a) have been admitted to a Degree of the University or a Degree of any other Statutory University;
 - (b) have prosecuted a regular course of study for the Examination for a period of not less than one academic year in a College, and
 - (c) have completed the age of 19 years on the date of submitting an application for admission to the examination.
5. Without prejudice to the other provisions of Ordinance No. relating to the Examinations in General, the provisions of Paragraphs 5, 8, 10 and 32 of the said Ordinance shall apply to every collegiate candidate.
6. The examination shall consist of following Three Parts, namely :-

Part-I	Theory	600 Marks.
Part-II	Skills	300 Marks.
Part-III	Teaching Ability or Practice Teaching	300 Marks.
7. (a) The examination under Part-I Theory shall be divided into two sections :-

Section-I	Annual Examination	480 Marks.
Section – II	Sessional Work	120 Marks.
- (b) In Section I, there shall be six papers of 80 marks each as mentioned below :-
 - 1) Paper-I : Principle and History of Physical Education;
 - 2) Paper- II : Educational and Sports Psychology;
 - 3) Paper-III : Organisation, Administration and Supervision of Physical Education;
 - 4) Paper-IV : Anatomy, Physiology and Health Education;

- 5) Paper-V : Educational Methodology;
6) Paper-VI : Officiating and Coaching;

(c) In Section II, One Written Test of 10 marks and one Assignment of 10 marks will be given under each paper in the course of training. Thus the Written Test in the Sessional Work for each paper will be of 20 marks, the total for six papers being 120 marks.

8. (a) The examination, under Part-II skills shall be divided in the Five sections 2-

1)Section-I	:	Major Games	90 Marks.
2)Section-II	:	Athletics	100 Marks.
3)Section-III	:	Formal Activities	50 Marks.
4)Section-IV	:	Gymnastics, Combative and Rhythmic	40 Marks.
5)Section -V	:	Practical Projects	20 Marks.

Total Marks : 300 Marks.

(b) The skills examination in section I,II, and III shall be partly internal and partly external. Section IV shall only be external and section V shall only be Internal. Total Internal Assessment shall be of 100 marks and the external examination will be of 200 marks.

9. (a) The examination under Part-III Practice Teaching shall be divided into two sections.

1)Section-I	:	Years Work	90 Marks.
2)Section-II	:	Two lessons to be given at the annual examination from each of the following group	210 Marks.
		(i) Physical Education (General) ;and	105 Marks.
		(ii) Special Subject (Opted by the candidate)	105 Marks.

(b) The teacher candidate shall take 30 lessons, 15 in physical education and 15 in special subject in recognized secondary school and submit these lessons plans to the principle for the his certification.

10. The fee for the examination shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time and whenever any change is made in the fees prescribed for any particular examination that shall be notified through a notification for information of the examinees concerned.

11. (a) The scope of the subjects shall be as indicated in the syllabus.

(b) The medium of instruction for the examination. shall be Marathi, Hindi or English and the question paper shall be set in Hindi, Marathi or English. Translations of the papers shall be provided in the other two languages also other

12. The Scheme of Examination shall be as provided under Appendix-I appended with this Ordinance .

13. A candidate who fails at the examination may he permitted to appear at the subsequent examination as an Ex-student. The marks obtained by such a

candidate for Sessional Work at the previous examinations will be repeated for consideration.

14. A candidate who fails in a paper or papers in Part-I or in any part or parts may be permitted to appear at the subsequent examination as an Ex-student in the paper or papers of Part-I or and in the part/s in which he has failed. Provided he obtains not less than 40% minimum pass marks in the aggregate of the respective part. Division will be assigned to such a candidate on the basis of marks obtained by him in the examination as a whole, Provided further that the candidate who fails in any part/s. for the examination on obtaining minimum pass marks in the aggregate of the respective part shall have to appear in the respective part/s completely as a whole.
15. In order to pass the examination an examinee must obtain (1) (a) Not less than 40% marks including internal assessment in each theory paper and Not less than 50% marks including internal assessment separately in (a) Part-II Skills and ('b) Part-III Practice teaching. In order to pass the examination, an examinee must secure at least 45% in aggregate consisting of all theory, practical's (skill based) and practice teaching subjects/head of passing.
16. (1) Successful examines obtaining aggregate marks from 75% and above shall be placed in Distinction division, those obtaining less than 75% and more than or equal to 60% shall be placed in First Division, those obtaining less than 60% but more than or equal to 45% shall be placed in second class and those obtaining less than 45% shall be declared as unsuccessful i.e. Fail.
17. Provision of Ordinance No. 7-A relating to Condo nation of Deficiency of Marks for Passing an examination shall apply to the Examination under this Ordinance.
18. As soon as possible after the examination but not later than 30** June next following, the Board of Examination shall publish a list of successful examinees arranged in Three Division. The names of those examinees passing the examination in the minimum prescribed period and obtaining the prescribed number of places in the First or Second Division shall be arranged in Order of Merit as provided in Ordinance No.6 relating to the Examinations In General.
19. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary in this Ordinance, no person shall be admitted to this examination if he has already passed this examination or an equivalent examination of any other Statutory University
20. Successful examinee shall receive a Degree, in the prescribed form, signed by the Vice-Chancellor.

(Statement of Object and Reasons)

To regulate the admissions and Examination leading to the one year Degree Course in Bachelor of Physical Education (B.P.Ed.) in the Faculty of Education, the Vice-Chancellor of the University had issued Direction No.105 of 2012 under Provision of section 14(8) of the Maharashtra University Act, 1994.

The said Direction is required to be converted into an Ordinance as Provided under the provision of the above mentioned Act, hence this Draft Ordinance is prepared for Consideration of the Academic Council and the Management Council of the University.
