## ORDINANCE NO. 99 OF 2017

EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF MASTER OF SCIENCE, SEMESTER PATTERN WITH CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM, IN THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE (AMENDMENT), ORDINANCE, 2017.

Whereas, it is expedient to prepare an ordinance in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, Semester pattern with choice based credit system i.e. Ordinance No. 79 of 2017, for the prupose hereinafter appearing, the Management Council is hereby pleased to make the following ordinance;

- 1. This Ordinance may be called "Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, Semester pattern with choice based credit system, in the Faculty of Science(Amendement) Ordinance, 2017".
- **2.** This Ordinance shall come into force with effect from the date of its making by the Management Council.
- **3.** In column 'K' of para '4' relating tp 'Eligibility to the course' relating to Ordinance No. 79 of 2017 in respect of Examinations leading to the Degree of Master of Science, semester pattern with choice based credit system, in the Faculty of Science, Ordinance, 2017
  - i) After the words and signs as "or B.Sc. Agriculture science" the words and sign as "with science stream at (10+2) level be added;
  - ii) The sign as 'appearing after the words 'Agriculture Science" be deleted.

## (Statement of object and reasons)

The Academic Council in its meeting held on 25/11/2016 vide item No. 61(B) on the agenda has resolved to make additional provision in the eligibility criteria for admission to M.Sc. semester 1 st in Environmental Science Degree Examination.

It was resolved that the B.Sc. Agriculture may be admitted to M.Sc. 1 st semester of Environmental Science degree course provided that the student should be from the science stream at the (10+2) level that is because an Ordinance No. 79 of 2017 was required to be amended, hence this Draft Ordinance is prepared for its consideration by the Academic Council and the Management Council.
