

DIRECTION NO. 14 OF 2017

EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF FASHION DESIGN (B.F.D.) (SIX SEMESTER DEGREE COURSE) BASED ON CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM IN THE FACULTY OF SCIENCE AND TECHNOLOGY DIRECTION, 2017.

(Issued under Provision of Section 12(8) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016.)

Whereas, The Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 has come into force with effect from 1st March 2017(Maharashtra Act No. VI of 2017) (hereinafter referred to as the Act);

AND

Whereas, the above mentioned Act is applicable to the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli from 1 st March, 2017;

AND

Whereas, the chairman, U.G.C. New Delhi has directed the Vice-Chancellor of the university to initiate steps for successful implementation of the choice based credit system(CBCS) from the Academic Session 2015-16 vide letter D.O.No.F-1-1/2015(CM) dated 8/01/2015;

AND

Whereas, the U.G.C. has formulated and issued guidelines on adoption of choice based credit system in all the universities;

AND

Whereas, the vice-chancellor has directed, on the basis of the resolution of the authorities of the university, to formulate and introduce choice based credit system at U.G. and P.G. level programme in all the faculties in the university;

AND

Whereas, the matter to introduce choice based credit system is required to be regulated by an ordinance to be made in this behalf;

AND

Whereas, no Ordinance is in existence in the university for introducing choice based credit system in the faculty of Science and Technology;

AND

Whereas, making of an Ordinance for introducing choice based credit system in the faculty of Science and Technology is a time consuming process;

AND

Whereas, the choice based credit system is to be introduced at the Bachelor of Fashion Design Degree level in the faculty of Science and Technology from the Academic year 2017-18.

Now, therefore, I, Dr. N.V. Kalyankar, Vice-Chancellor, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli in exercise of the powers vested in me under provision of section 12(8) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act,2016 do hereby issue following Directions:-

- 1. This Direction shall be called "Examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Fashion Design (B.F.D.) (Six semester Degree Course) based on Choice based credit system in the faculty of Science and Technology, Direction, 2017."
- **2.** This Direction shall come into force with effect from the Academic year 2017-18 for Ist and IInd semester of the Bachelor degree course and onwards i.e. Bachelor of Fashion Design Degree.
- **3.** (i) The following shall be the examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Fashion Design.
 - Bachelor of Fashion Design Part-I, semester I and II Examinations
 - **2.** Bachelor of Fashion Design Part II, semester III and IV examinations
 - **3.** Bachelor of Fashion Design Part III, semester V and VI examinations.
 - (ii) The Duration of the program: The duration of undergraduate (U.G.) program for Bachelor of Fashion Design (BFD) shall be of three academic years consisting of six semesters.
 - Admission and Eligibility criteria: Subject to his compliance with the provisions of this direction and of other ordinance in force from time to time, an applicant for admission to semester I of Bachelor of Fashion Design , have passed XII standard examination of M.S. Board of Secondary and Higher Secondary education or any other examination recognized as equivalent there to with not less than 40% marks under the following the discipline of Science/Home Science/Arts/commerce with English as one of the subjects.

4. In the case of (Bachelor of Fashion DesignPart-II, Sem-III & IV) Examinations: - have passed not less than one academic year previously the (Bachelor of Fashion Design Part-I, Sem-I & II) Examinations of the University or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto, and candidates who have passed the 2 or 3 years Diploma of MSBTE in dress designing and manufacturing and diploma in garment technology shall be given admission in bachelor of Fashion design 2nd year (sem III) with minimum 50 % marks.

In the case of the (Bachelor of Fashion Design Final, Sem-V & VI) Examinations:- have passed not less than one academic year previously the (Bachelor of Fashion DesignPart-II, Sem-III & IV) Examinations of the University or an examination recognized as equivalent thereto:

5. <u>Norms of A.T.K.T:</u>

- **6.** There shall be total six semesters, in U.G. level of Bachelor of Fashion Design program Each semester shall comprise of 90 (Ninety) actual teaching days.
- **7.** All theory papers shall be divided into four units.
- **8.** The scope and limitations of the subjects of all semesters opted by the students shall be indicated in the respective syllabi from time to time. The medium of instructions and examinations shall be English,/ Marathi / Hindi except for the course in language

- **9.** The fees for the tuition, examination, Laboratory and other fees shall be as prescribed by the University from time to time. The theory question paper will follow similar pattern for maximum subjects with inter unit choice and equal weightage to all questions. Duration of each theory paper shall be three hours. There will be five questions each. Fifth question will be based on entire syllabus. All questions shall be compulsory with internal choice. Questions may be subdivided into sub questions.
- **10.** All theory examinations shall be conducted by Gondwana University Gadchiroli at the end of each Semester.
- 11 Practical examination for all semesters shall be conducted once in a year, at the end of 2nd.4th and 6th semester, by Gondwana University, Gadchiroli. At every odd semester i.e. 1st, 3rd and 5th, semester there shall be internal assessment for the practicals completed, record of which should be put before the external examiner at the time of university practical examination.
- **12.** Duration of practical examinations shall be 3 hrs, for one or two day, depending upon subject and number of students
- **13** Practical batch shall be of 16 students.
- **14.** Marks should be allotted according to the marking scheme.
- **15** The number of papers, practicals, teaching hours, the maximum marks allotted to and minimum marks which an examinee must obtain in order to pass the examination shall be as indicated under Appendices I, II,III, IV, V and VI appended with this direction.
- **16**. The scheme of awarding marks for internal assessment with every detail shall be as per appendix **C** with this Direction.
- 17. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary of this direction no candidates shall be admitted to Bachelor of Fashion Design I, (semester I and II), Bachelor of Fashion Design II- (Sem-III and IV) and Bachelor of Fashion Design final semester (V and VI) examinations under this direction, if she has already passed the corresponding or an equivalent examination of any other statutory University.
- 18. As soon as possible after the examinations the Board of Examination and evaluation shall publish a list of successful examinees at the Bachelor of Fashion Design Sem-I ⅈ Bachelor of Fashion Design, Sem-III & IV and Bachelor of Fashion Design V & VI Examinations. The result of all examinations shall be classified on the basis of semester Grade point Average 'SGPA' evaluated as specified in the adopted model Credit-Grade system.
- **19**. The examinees who have secured pass grade in all subjects prescribed for all the examinations shall be eligible for the award of Degree of Bachelor of Fashion Design . The classification of division of examinees for the award of

Degree of Bachelor of Fashion Design shall be on the basis of Cumulative Grade Point Average 'CGPA' evaluated by accounting SGPA of V and VI semester.

- **20** Successful Examinees at the final examination shall be on payment of the prescribed fees, will be entitled for the award of the degree in the prescribed form signed by the Vice Chancellor.
- **21**. **Absorption scheme to switch over from yearly to semester pattern** (From other University to Gondwana University)
 - a) The candidates who have cleared first year annual pattern examination in the subject shall get admission to third semester directly by match able scheme. However, candidates who are allowed to keep term will not be eligible for admission to third semester unless they clear all the papers and practicals of first year annual pattern examination.
 - **b)** Admission to 5th semester, student should clear second year annual pattern examination in all subjects.
