

**DIRECTION NO.14 OF 2018**

**EXAMINATIONS LEADING TO THE DEGREE OF BACHELOR OF SOCIAL WORK(B.S.W.)(SIX SEMESTER THREE YEAR DEGREE COURSE) BASED ON THE CHOICE BASED CREDIT SYSTEM(CBCS) IN THE FACULTY OF INTER-DISCIPLINARY STUDIES(AMENDMENT) DIRECTION, 2018**

(Issued under Section 12(8) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016.)

Whereas, The Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016 has come into force with effect from 1<sup>st</sup> March 2017;(Maharashtra Act No. VI of 2017)

**AND**

Whereas, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli is established by the Government of Maharashtra Vide Notification No. MISC-2010/(252/10)UNI-4 Dated 27<sup>th</sup> September,2011 as State University offering various academic programs beginning from the academic session 2012-13;

**AND**

Whereas, the above mentioned Act is applicable to the Gondwana University, Gadchiroli from 1<sup>st</sup> March, 2017;

**AND**

Whereas, the chairman, U.G.C. New Delhi has directed the Vice-Chancellor of the University to initiate steps for successful implementation of the choice based credit system(CBCS) from the academic session 2015-16 vide letter D.O. No. F-1-1/2015(CM) dated 8<sup>th</sup> January, 2015;

**AND**

Whereas, the U.G.C. has formulated and issued guidelines on adoption of choice based credit system(CBCS) in all the Universities ;

**AND**

Whereas, the Vice-Chancellor has directed, on the basis of the resolution of the authorities, to formulate and introduce choice based credit system at UG and PG level programme in all the faculties of this University;

**AND**

Whereas, the matter to introduce choice based credit system was required to be regulated by an ordinance to be made in this behalf;

**AND**

Whereas, no ordinance was in existence in the University for introducing choice based credit system in the Faculty of Inter-disciplinary studies;

**AND**

Whereas, making of an ordinance for introducing choice based credit system in the Faculty of Inter-disciplinary Studies was a time consuming process;

**AND**

Whereas, the choice based credit system was to be introduced at the Bachelor of Social Work(B.S.W.) degree level programme in the Faculty of Inter-disciplinary studies from the Academic Session 2017-18;

**AND**

Whereas, the Vice-Chancellor of the university on 16/12/2017 had issued Direction No. 41 of 2017 under provision of section 12(8) of the Maharashtra Public Universities Act, 2016, to regulate the matter relating to Bachelor of Social Work programme based on choice based credit system;

**AND**

Whereas, Direction No. 41 of 2017 is yet to be converted into the Ordinance;

**AND**

Whereas, all SGPA/CGPA relating to the B.S.W. programme are based on 07 Point scale in Direction No. 41 of 2017;

**AND**

Whereas, 07 point scale grade is required to be substituted by the 10 point scale grade by 10 point scale grade in Direction No. 41 of 2017, the said Direction No. 41 of 2017 is required to be amended.

Now, therefore, I, Dr. N.V. Kalyankar, Vice-chancellor, Gondwana University, Gadchiroli in exercise of the powers conferred on me under provision of sub-section(8) of section 12 of the Maharashtra Public University Act, 2016, do hereby issue following Directions to amend Direction No. 41 of 2017:-

1. This Direction shall be called "Examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Social Work(B.S.W.)(Six semester Three Year Degree Course) Based on the Choice Based Credit System(CBCS) in the Faculty of Inter-disciplinary Studies(Amendment)Direction, 2018 ."
2. This Direction shall come into force with effect from the date of its issuance.
3. Clause(iv) of sub-para 4 of para 4(4.4(iv)) of Direction No. 41 of 2017 in respect of "Examinations leading to the Degree of Bachelor of Social Work (B.S.W.)(Six Semester three year Degree course) based on the choice based credit system (CBCS)in the Faculty of Inter-disciplinary studies Direction, 2017" which states as "(iv) All SGPA/CGPA shall be on 07 point scale only as substitute by the following:-  
" 4.4(iv) All SGPA/CGPA in the social work Degree programme shall be based on 10 point scale mentioned in the following table:-
